

# RSS

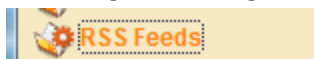

## Overview

RSS is a way to summarize and syndicate data. Many websites provide RSS feeds that allow an easy, automated way to check for site updates. WizMailer can check RSS feeds and show updated entries in webmail or your IMAP client.

## Setup

To start, go to Settings -> RSS Feeds in webmail.



Click Add RSS Folder.

Enter a folder name, and then click Add RSS folder on the following page. This is the folder name you will see in your email client.

After you have added an RSS folder, you will be returned to the list of folders. Select the radio button next to your folder and click the Edit button.

Next, click the "Add Feed" button. On the following page you will be prompted to enter the information about the feed. If you know the URL you can enter it here. Otherwise you can choose from our library of feeds by clicking "Browse Library."

After you have entered your address, you will need to choose the retention policy. This just determines how long the feed data is stored in your account. You can choose to the items removed as soon as they are read, a certain amount of time after they are read, or only when they are deleted.

Retention Policy:

Never remove item

Remove after I have read an item

Remove item after

Click "Add feed to folder" when you have selected the option you want.

**Add Feed to Folder**

Your RSS feed is now setup. You can add as many as you want to the folder you just created, or create new folders to organize your RSS feeds. It will take a short while for your feed to update for the first time. When it does, you will see new messages in the folder "My RSS Feeds."
